

1. Pauls lantern Patent June 30, 1903, made by Wheeling Stamping Co. Wheeling W. Va. ( Wheeling out of business 1946 )
- 2 Dietz Hi-Lo ( hot blast ) Mfg. date Nov. 1939 last patent date May 1920. Lantern used mostly by contractors of public works Railroads, bridge and highway work etc. Most were sold with red globes.
- 3 Dietz monarch ( early style ) Flat font, Old style burner lantern moderately rare
- 4 F.O. Dewey Mill lantern with Dietz Cross Circle Logo on bottom of lantern. ( Dietz first used the cross circle logo in 1891 and switched to the oval logo by 1904. F.O. Dewey operated a mfg. facility at 28 Canal and 29 Merrimac street in Boston Mass. They contracted some of their lanterns, thus the Dietz logo. Very rare lantern
- 5 Dietz D-lite ( cold Blast ) large font. fairly common lantern
- 6 Dietz Victor ( Dome font square tube ) Made from about 1910 until 1939. ( sold overseas after 1939 ) 9/16 brass cap      Rare Lantern
- 7 Dietz Victor ( has later larger 13/16" fuel cap
- 8 Dietz Victor with small 9/16" brass fuel cap. In 1899 the Dietz Victor sold for 37 cents. RARE
- 9 Dietz STAR square tube. hot blast flat top font. RARE
- 10 Dietz MILL Lantern, Hot blast, square tube, flat top font. made to underwriters specs for insurance approval. used in mills

plants & mfg. facilities with fire risk areas. RARE

11 Dietz LITTLE WIZZARD cold blast Mfg. in 1928. not rare

12 Dietz LITTLE WIZZARD cold blast. Mfg. date 1945. not rare

13 Dietz ACME INSPECTORS LANTERN used by U.S. life saving service, railroads, Police Agencies, etc. The last square tube lantern made by Dietz. mfg. date Feb. 1936

14 Dietz ACME INSPECTORS LANTERN ( can't read mfg. date ) this lantern made by Dietz from about 1900 until 1945

15 Dietz ACME INSPECTORS LANTERN ( can't read mfg. date )

16 Dietz PROTECTOR TRACKWALKER LANTERN ( mfg. date Feb. 1927 ) embossed with Pennsylvania railroad "keystone" logo. has a white semaphore lense at the rear and a ruby red lense which can be thrown by a lever to replace the white lens to signal danger.

17 Dietz JUNIOR WAGON LANTERN made from about 1914 until 1945. has ruby red lense to reflect light to rear.

18 Dietz monarch ( mfg. date 1934 )

19 dietz monarch ( mfg. date 1922 )

20 dietz MONARCH ( can't read mfg. date ) The Monarch was among the most widely produced lanterns by Dietz

21 Dietz D-LITE ( mfg. date 1928 ) this model made from about 1919 until 1941

22 Dietz MONARCH STREAMLINE ( MADE FROM 1938 UNTIL THE 1960'S )

23 Dietz MONARCH STREAMLINE The streamline can be distinguished by the limb like stamped markings on the vent tube.

24 Dietz D-LITE ( large font ) mfg. date Feb. 1931

25 Dietz # 100 ( COMET STREAMLINE ) made from 1939 until the 1960's. "This lantern made for P.S.E.& G. Co.( Public Service Electric & Gas Company of New Jersey

26 Dietz MILL LANTERN ( has R.J. REYNOLDS TOBACCO COMPANY brass lable on font. ) Mill lanterns were made for factories and mills to be used in fire hazzard areas. RARE

27 Dietz #8 AIR PILOT imported from Hong Kong after 1956 very common lantern.

28 C.T. HAM CLIPPER (cold blast) C.T. HAM lantern co. went out of business about 1914. All C.T. HAM lanterns pre date 1915 therefore can be considered rare.

29 Dietz HI-LO Mfg. at Syracuse N.Y. plant in 1929

30 Dietz BLIZZARD (made from about 1912 until 1945)

31 C.T. HAM "RELIABLE" (COLD BLAST #22) has brass cone

32 C.T. HAM #2 cold blast (domed font)

33 Dietz HI-LO mfg. at Sycaruse N.Y. Plant Jan. 1941

34 Defiance lantern, copper font, amber globe. Defiance was in business from 1900 until 1935. Went broke in the stock market crash of 1929. Sold out to Embury in 1935. RARE

35 Lantern made by Defiance lantern co. for Belknap Hardware of Louville Ky. (blue grass brand) Any bluegrass hardware is very collectable.

36 Lantern made by Defiance Lantern & Stamping Co. for Belknap Hardware of Louville Ky.(blue grass is a brand name for belknap) Most Defiance lanterns were tin plated, painted red or Japanned laquered blue.

37 Defiance #2 TRIUMPH (has match striker on vent tube)  
Defiance out of business by 1935

38 Defiance (large font) "RIVAL"

39 C.T. Ham "CLIPPER" C.T. Ham out of business in 1914.

40 Wheeling Stamping Co. "REGAL" (pat. June 30, 1909

41 Wheeling Stamping Co. (Paull's #230 cold blast) finish bright tin or painted red

42 Wheeling Stamping Co. #140 REGAL hot blast. Pat.June 30 1903

43 Wheeling Stamping Co. (PAULL'S) 1897-1946 Paull's used a Bakelite fuel cap.

44 Wheeling Stamping Co. (PAULL'S) the lantern has a Paull's Leader embossed globe. Lantern is fairly common, globe is rare

45 Wheeling Stamping Co. PAULL'S LEADER (cold blast) "EZY-LIT"  
Pat. date May 7 1914

46 Wheeling Stamping Co. PAULL'S. PAT. JUNE 30, 1903.  
lantern has wrong cone & burner.

47 Lantern made by Embury Lantern Co. as a private brand name  
for Marshall Wells Hardware Co. of Duluth Minnesota. Rare

48 Embury SUPREME (hot blast) early model #210. Embury was in  
business form 1917 until 1953

49 Embury SUPREME #210 (hot blast) 1917-1953

50 Lantern mfg. by Embury Lantern Co. for Belknap Hardware  
(blue grass brand) of Louville Ky. (Patented after the Air  
Pilot) All blue grass hardware is collectable.

51 Embury LITTLE AIR PILOT made from 1940's until 1962  
Dietz produced this model after 1953.

52 Elgin was a brand name for Sears & Roebuck. The lantern  
was made by Embury Mfg. Co. (very similar to the Little Air  
Pilot.

53 Embury #2 AIR PILOT <sup>1939</sup> 1917-1953

54 Rayo "Bulls Eye" Dash Lantern or Wagon Lamp. (globe is  
embossed "RAYO BULLSEYE" and is rare. Rayo was a brand name  
for Standard Oil, and they contracted out most of the production  
of their lanterns.

55 RAYO #77 (cold blast) appears to be made by Defiance

Lantern co.

56 RAYO #77 (cold blast) Appears to be made by Defiance Lantern Co.

57 Berger Mfg. Co. STORM KING made in Canton Ohio. Rare Lantern

58 Buhl CONQUEST MADE FROM 1913 UNTIL 1930. pre 1913 did not have a domed font. Buhl's was in business from 1888 until 1956

59 Dietz JUNIOR (1939 until 1960's) used by boy scouts.

60 NIER #280 Feuerhand. Made in Germany. well made lantern.

61 BEACON (G.S.W.) Made by General Steel Ware Limited of Tronto, Ontario Canada. (a maker of stamped sheet metal products.

62 Dietz NIGHT WATCH (1945-1953) sold as highway contractors Lantern.

63 Pritchard & Storm PRISCO. has brass cone and 9/16 inch brass cap. Pat. date Jan 9, 1906. Pritchard & Storm went into business about 1905 and appear to be out of business by 1918 May have sold out to Defiance Lantern Co. RARE

64 Dietz #40 TRAFFIC GUARD first made by Embury until Dietz bought them out in 1953. Lantern was made until 1962.

65 Waterbury brass skate lantern. Waterbury Ct. RARE

66 Handlan construction lantern used highway markers, Guard house light etc. This lantern made for Consolidated Edison System.

67 Handlan construction lantern (unmarked)

68 Handlan construction lantern embossed B.U.G. Co.

69 Perkins stern or anchor lantern (nautical) fresnel lens. RARE

70 National Marine Lamp Co. (nautical) stern or anchor lamp Rare

71 World Standard Deck Lantern (Dietz) Brass lantern, tie down rings, Green Globe,  
Made for U.S. Navy during WW1 VERY RARE

72 Dietz Vesta Navy standard Deck Lantern (Brass) Patent Dec. 13, 1910  
RARE

73 Perkins De-Lite (Perko) Side Lantern (1937-1960) Oil or 12 volt Electric

74 Perkins Not sure what this lantern was used for. Similar to Perkins  
De-Lite  
Side Lantern

75 Police Flash Light. Lantern used by Police, Firemen, & Rescue personell.  
This lamp has a Sperm or Signal oil burner which was used from about 1830  
until about 1890

76 Dietz Orient Motor Coach Lamp. Patent Jan. 26, 1897

77 C.T. Ham "GEM" All brass with nickel plate. Most of the plating is worn  
away.

78 Model T Ford Kerosene side lamp (model 560) Patent May 26 1914-- June  
23, 1914
