




CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Burns , State of Oregon, 97720 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Poison Creek Slough

a tributary of Silvies River irrigation of 404.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 22436 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 5.04 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE_4 , NE_4 , Section 24, T. 23 S., R. 31 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shal

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


