Dear Mr. Goll:

We have been advised by the Yakima County Courthouse that you are the current owner of parcel 181429-14005. This parcel has a total water right of 4.00 inches. This equates to 45.00 gallons per minute.

Enclosed for your information is a list of the District Rules and Regulations. Also enclosed is the phone numbers for the office and your patrolman with his days off during the water season. Our irrigation system is a gravity flow system necessitating that you keep your water going 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The water is delivered to a water box where the water is measured. The collector tile and beyond that point is the water user's responsibility to maintain.

All water orders must be made to the office or the patrolman by 2 p.m. of any day for the adjustment to be made the next day. The water comes from the Naches River and takes a full day for the changes to get through our system. Please keep in mind that the Naches-Selah Irrigation District is a totally gravity flow district. Water usage is based on a 24 hour a day, 7 day a week usage. The District has no reservoir capacity. Any water adjustments are made from the Naches River above the White Pass turnoff. It takes most of a day for water adjustments to reach the Selah area. Our system is not designed for automated systems that run on timers or for the users that attempt to water everything on evenings and weekends. This causes tremendous fluctuation in the system where other water users either get flooded or possibly have their pumps burn out due to lack of water. Due to the lack of total control of our system, we cannot guarantee that the water will not fluctuate. For this reason, we strongly suggest that every water user or delivery, have a shut off valve or a float switch to protect your pumps. Please call the office for any water questions. Leave a message on the answering machine if no one is in the office. Our patrolmen are on duty seven days a week during water season. A relief patrolman runs the route on the days that the normal patrolmen are off. By calling the office, your request should be handled more efficiently and timely, and the patrolmen are allowed their free time as well. If there is an emergency, (a break in the line, flooding, or absolutely no water whatsoever), by all means call the patrolman in the evening or any of the other patrolmen and they will attempt to get it taken care of promptly. For your own protection we suggest that you place a float control valve or pressure shut off valve on your pump if you use one.



It is imperative that you give us 24 hour notice before you turn your water on or off. If you do not contact us, you are running somebody else low on water, possibly burning up a pump or flooding out someone downstream.

Please call the office with a home phone number and a daytime number and let me know if either number is unlisted. Please call me if you have any more questions or concerns.

We have been advised by the Yakima County Courthouse that you are the current owner of parcel 181429-41001. This parcel has a total water right of 8.00 inches. This equates to 90.00 gallons per minute.

Enclosed for your information is a list of the District Rules and Regulations. Also enclosed is the phone numbers for the office and your patrolman with his days off during the water season. Our irrigation system is a gravity flow system necessitating that you keep your water going 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The water is delivered to a water box where the water is measured. The collector tile and beyond that point is the water user's responsibility to maintain.

All water orders must be made to the office or the patrolman by 2 p.m. of any day for the adjustment to be made the next day. The water comes from the Naches River and takes a full day for the changes to get through our system. Please keep in mind that the Naches-Selah Irrigation District is a totally gravity flow district. Water usage is based on a 24 hour a day, 7 day a week usage. The District has no reservoir capacity. Any water adjustments are made from the Naches River above the White Pass turnoff. It takes most of a day for water adjustments to reach the Selah area. Due to the lack of total control of our system, we cannot guarantee that the water will not fluctuate. RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DELIVERY OF WATER FROM;
THE NACHES SELAH IRRIGATION DISTRICT
DATED 8-15-89

1. Water users desiring water turned on, water turned off or changed from one measuring box to another, or neighbors desiring to exchange water must give 24 hours notice of such change to the Ditch Patrolman on the lateral where such change is to be made or request changes at the NSID office .
2. No obstruction, dam or diversion works of any kind shall be placed in the canal or in any of the laterals under the control of the officers of the Irrigation District by any water user. All such dams or diversion works as are necessary for the proper delivery of water from the canal or any lateral will be placed therein only under the supervision of the Directors of the District or the Superintendent of the canals of the District.
3. No Water user shall allow his supply of water to run to useless waste or to permit any waste water to run back into any of the canals or laterals of the ditch without first having secured the express consent of the Directors therefor, and said waste water must be conducted into the canal or lateral in such a manner as shall be approved by the Board of Directors.
4. Tampering with measuring boxes, locks, or appliances , whittling or otherwise enlarging the openings after same shall have been set, and changing delivery of water from one side of the measuring box to another is strictly forbidden under the penalty of the law in such cases provided.
5. No water user shall close or obstruct any gage or valve delivering water to him or upon his land so that same shall be thrown back into the canal or lateral of the District without the express consent of the Superintendent of the canal or the Ditch Patrolman of the said irrigation lateral. 24 hours before the water user has finished his irrigation, desiring water to be shut off, he shall notify the Ditch Patrolman having charge of that lateral delivering water to his said lands; said notice to be oral, by telephone, or by written notice tacked to the measuring box of said water user.
6. All gates, turnouts, valves, and delivery devices must be kept locked by the Ditch Patrolman unless otherwise ordered by the Board of Directors, or the Superintendent of said District.






