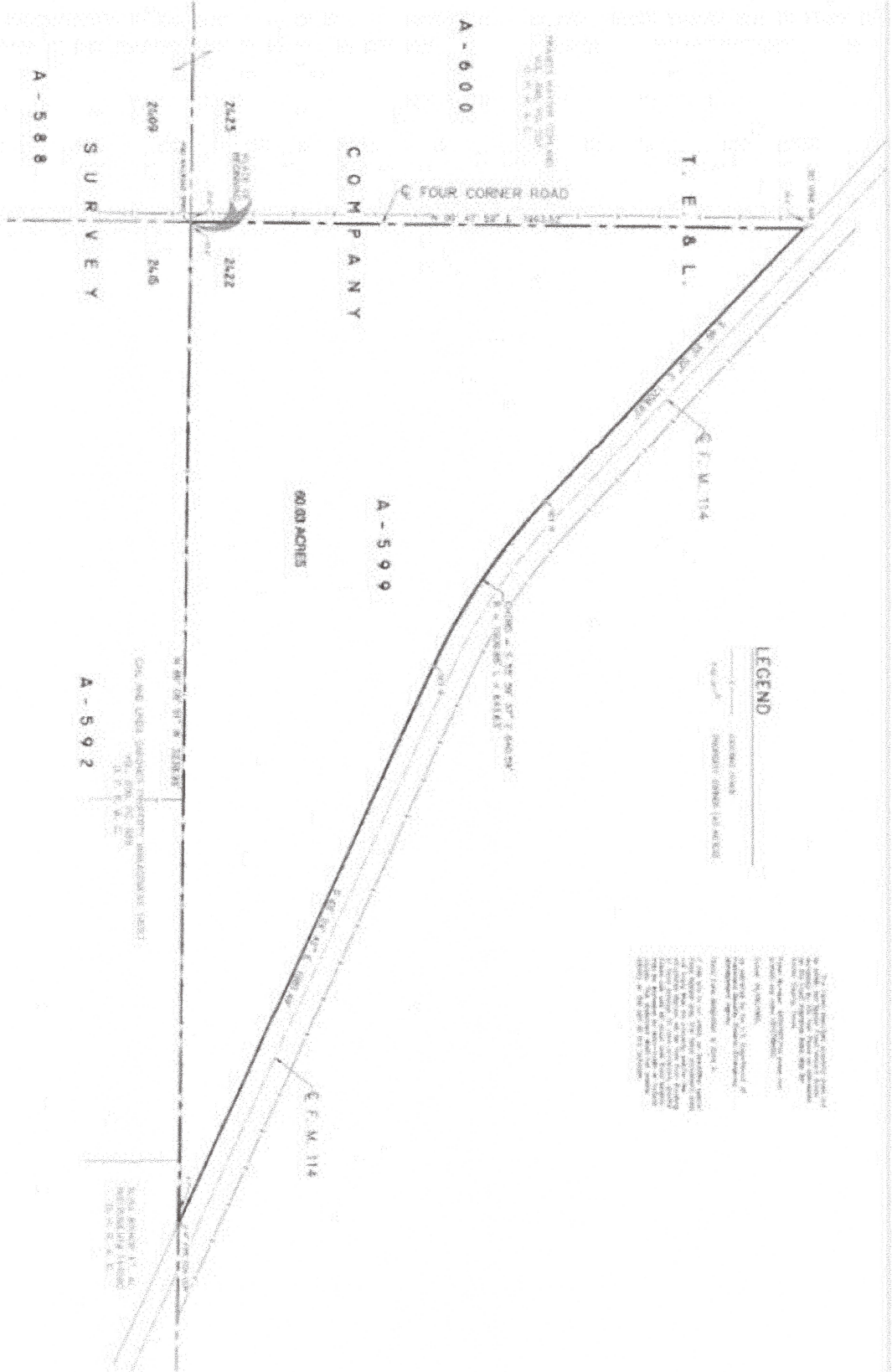




LEGEND
