Thence: S 20° 25′ 57″ E with the West line of said called 1.94 acre tract, 427.37 feet to a ½″ iron rod set for the Point of Beginning on the proposed North Right-of-Way line of U.S. Highway No. 59, 70.00 feet at right angles, right from the survey centerline of U.S. Highway No. 59, hereinafter referred to as the "survey centerline" at survey centerline station 81+90.74;
