## INFORMATION REGARDING THE REAL ESTATE SELLER DISCLOSURE LAW

4 The Real Estate Seller Disclosure Law (68 P.S. §7301, et seq.) requires that before an agreement of sale is signed, the seller in a residential 5 real estate transfer must disclose all known **material defects** about the property being sold that are not readily observable. This Statement is not a warranty of any kind by Seller or a warranty or rep15 resentation by any listing real estate broker, any selling real estate broker, or their licensees. Buyer is encouraged to address concerns about the condition of the Property that may not be included in this Statement.

17 The Law provides exceptions (listed below) where a property disclosure statement does not have to be completed. All other sellers are obligated to complete a property disclosure statement, even if they do not occupy or have never occupied the Property.

- 1. Transfers by a fiduciary during the administration of a decedent estate, guardianship, conservatorship or trust.
- 20 2. Transfers as a result of a court order.
- 3. Transfers to a mortgage lender that results from a buyer's default and subsequent foreclosure sales that result from default.
- 4. Transfers from a co-owner to one or more other co-owners.
- 5. Transfers made to a spouse or direct descendant.
- 6. Transfers between spouses as a result of divorce, legal separation or property settlement.
- 7. Transfers by a corporation, partnership or other association to its shareholders, partners or other equity owners as part of a plan of liquidation.

  - a. The buyer has received a one-year warranty covering the construction;
  - b. The building has been inspected for compliance with the applicable building code or, if none, a nationally recognized model building code; and
    - c. A certificate of occupancy or a certificate of code compliance has been issued for the dwelling.

Although the provisions of the Real Estate Seller Disclosure Law exclude some transfers from the requirement of completing a disclosure statement, the Law does not excuse the seller's common law duty to disclose any known material defect(s) of the Property in order to avoid fraud, misrepresentation or deceit in the transaction. **This duty continues until the date of settlement.**
