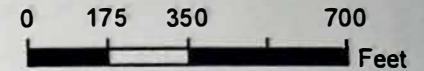

Hello CRP producer,

This letter is regarding the required annual CRP certification.

All CRP contracts are to be certified by **July, 15th**. By completing the certification, you are agreeing to the following items:

1. The CRP acres as listed are correct (row crops have not encroached on the area).
2. The CRP shares listed are correct.
3. The CRP is being properly maintained (weeds, volunteer trees, erosion).
4. All CRP program provisions are being followed, including:
 1. Not using the CRP as a lane
 2. Not mowing or burning without permission during primary nesting season (May 15th - August 1st.)
 3. No permanent structures on the CRP (hunting stands, equipment, sheds, driveways, etc...)
 4. No permanent pathways through the CRP/pathways that are regularly mowed and killing/reducing grass cover
5. Requesting permission before incidental grazing, in conjunction with the gleaning of crop residue in the adjoining field

Included is the annual certification along with a copy for your records. Sign and return to the office by the date mentioned above.
