

**Schedule of User Fees at Lake Coldwater**  
**(Fees do not include use of ball fields or golf course.)**

	<b>3-Day Permit</b>	<b>Season Permit</b>
1. Vehicle Permit.....	\$.55	\$15
2. Boats (includes 1 free vehicle pass) .....	\$25	\$75
3. Jet Skis (includes 1 free vehicle pass).....	\$35	\$125
4. Sailboats.....	\$.10	\$.30
5. Golf Cart.....	.....	\$.30

Vehicle permits cover driving in the park, sightseeing, swimming, fishing, picnicking, hiking and non-powered boats or boats under 10 horse power. Second and third vehicle permits within the same household are \$10 each.

**Camping Fees**

**Cabins**

1. Ryan's Cabin (East Side)... \$75 Per Night With A 7-day Limit
2. Locust Lodge (West Side)...\$75 Per Night With A 7-day Limit

**Shelter Rates/Rules**

1. Small shelters – No charge (No reservations – first come, first served)
2. Time limit imposed on use of small shelters
3. Large shelter - \$40 per day (RESERVATION ONLY)
4. No camping at shelters or in immediate area

**Vehicle permits must be affixed to the lower left corner of windshield.  
 Boat and jet ski permits must be affixed to trailer on the side closest to the ticket booth**

### ❖ GOLF CART REGULATIONS

GOLF CARTS are allowed, but MUST HAVE A PERMIT AND MUST STAY ON AUTHORIZED ROADS

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL TO DRIVE A GOLF CART ON THE GRASS OR ON UNAUTHORIZED ROADS OTHER THAN PARKING NEXT TO A CAMPER. If caught driving on the grass or unauthorized roads, the following procedure will be followed: 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: A fine no greater than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) will be issued by authorized personnel, including, but not limited to, the Lake Manager, Public Works Director, City Code Enforcer and Law Enforcement. 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: Two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) fine and revocation of golf cart permit, and revocation of privileges to operate a golf cart on lake property. 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) fine plus expulsion from lake property for a period of one calendar year from date of third offense  
PURSUANT TO KSA. 8-15,108 GOLF CARTS SHALL BE PERMITTED TO OPERATE AT LAKE COLDWATER ONLY DURING THE HOURS BETWEEN SUNRISE AND SUNSET

- ❖ Kansas law (KSA 32-1128) requires that vessels towing person(s) on water skis or other similar devices carry and use a bright orange skier-down flag, at least 12 x 12 inches in size, whenever the towed person(s) is in the water preparing to be towed or waiting to be picked up by the towing vessel. The flags may be purchased at the entrance booth at the lake
